



Live Local Marketplace opens today

Designed to revitalize a dull stretch of Dundas Street West, the Live Local Marketplace at Scadding Court Community Centre launches today and tomorrow.

The new open-air market is comprised of brightly coloured re-purposed shipping containers lining the exterior concrete wall along the south side of Dundas Street West, just east of Bathurst Street.

There will be a variety of vendors at the market including Monfortes artisanal cheese, DJ's Caribbean Creole Cuisine and Island Fresh foods. The vendors will be selling food and goods.

The market will run year-round, Mondays to Saturdays from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.

On Friday and Saturday nights during the summer, plans are vendors will be open to midnight, creating Toronto's first Night Market with performances and open air film screenings.

Toronto's Live Local Marketplace grand opening is Sept. 24 and 25 from 6 to 11 p.m. at 707 Dundas St. W. and will feature vendors, film screenings and live performances.
