

FAQ for West Side and Market 707 Farmers' Market

Q1. What is the time frame for the Farmers' Market?

- The **West Side Farmers Market** will run every Monday from 3pm-7pm starting June 2nd until September 29th 2014
- The **Market 707 Farmers Market** will run every Thursday from 3pm-7pm starting May 1st until September 25th 2014, with an official launch celebration on May 15th, 2014

Q2. What is the payment structure and are there discounts available?

- The **West Side Farmers' Market** fees are \$35 per week (\$630 for the whole season, 18 weeks)
- A discounted fee of \$530 is available for farmers who commit to the whole season (18 weeks). Payment must be made in full in advance of the season
- Vendors can also choose to pay on a monthly basis all payments must be in made in advanced of the beginning of the month
- **Market 707 Farmers' Market** fees are \$25 per week (\$550 for the whole season, 22 weeks)
- A discounted fee of \$450 is available for farmers who commit to the whole season (22 weeks). Payment must be made in full in advance of the season
- Vendors can also choose to pay on a monthly basis all payments must be in made in advanced of the beginning of the month

Q3. What is the maximum number of farmers we can accommodate?

- Maximum 20 vendors

Q4. How much space do I have to work with?

- **West Side Farmers Market** each vendor is given a standard space of 10x10, accommodations can be made for vendors requiring more space
- Each farmer is responsible for bringing their own equipment (tables, chairs, tents, signage etc.)
- **Market 707 Farmers Market** each vendor is given one space, which is a standard parking space size (8ftx8 ft)
- Tables, measured at (6ft x 2.5ft) and chairs will be provided
- Each farmer is responsible for bringing their own equipment (tents, signage etc.)

Q5. What about electricity?

- No electricity (outlets, power bars, extension cords etc.) will be provided by the sites.

Q6. Are there restrictions on products?

- We have no restrictions on food item farmers can sell (selling bulk items, dry goods, seeds, hemp, oats, flour , produce, vegetables, organic skin care products, etc)
- Farmers can resell items brought with them that were produced by other farmers
- For vendors looking to sell other non-food items (hand made jewellery, crafts, etc.) there will be opportunities for these types of vendors on special events days, space permitting

Q7. Will we have a set number of farmers allowed to sell the same products?

- We are striving to have a diverse range of products, it is in your best interest to confirm your spot as soon as possible

Q8. Where can I find parking in the area?

- **West Side Farmers' Market** free parking is provided on site for vendors
- **Market 707 Farmers' Market** no parking on site; however we have plenty of paid parking options in the area. We are trying to make special arrangements with parking venues nearby A map will be provided marking all available parking options in the area
- There will be an access area for trucks/cars to load and unload their products located by the front gate of the SCCC parking lot
