



## Post-G20 town hall Thursday night

A community-level discussion about the impacts of the G20 weekend on Toronto is set to take place this Thursday, July 28 at the Scadding Court Community Centre, 707 Dundas St. W.

Hosted by Equity Toronto and Community Education&Access to Police Complaints (CEAPC), the Post-G20 Town Hall Event will run from 7 to 9 p.m.
